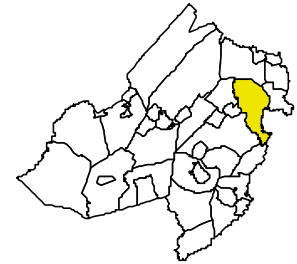




MONTVILLE TOWNSHIP

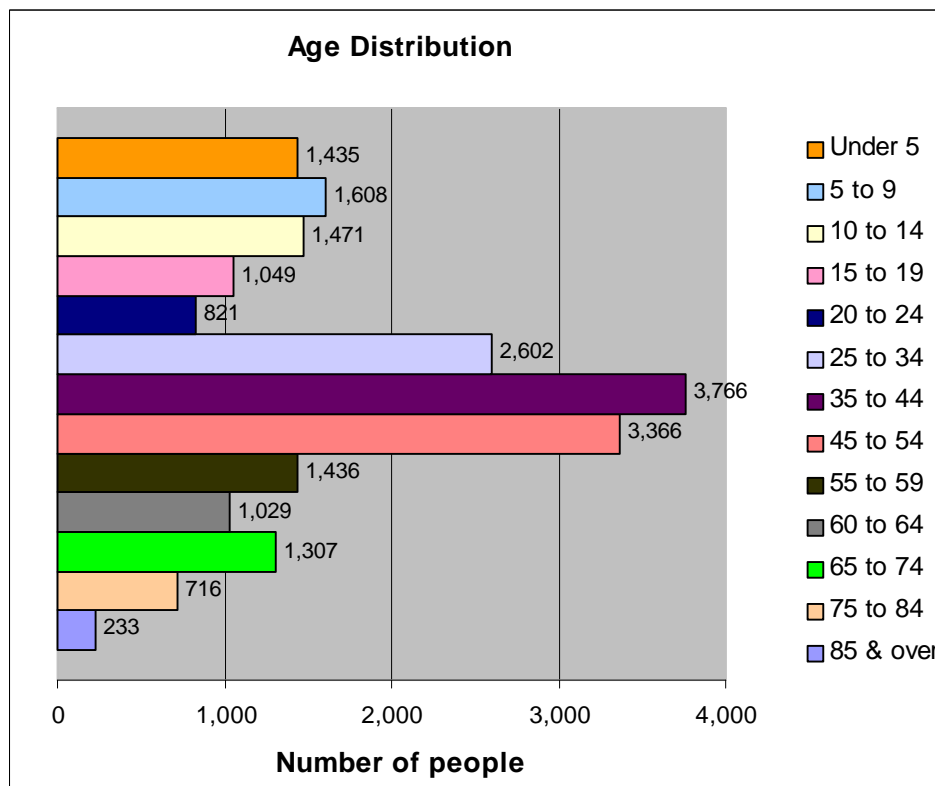


OVERVIEW

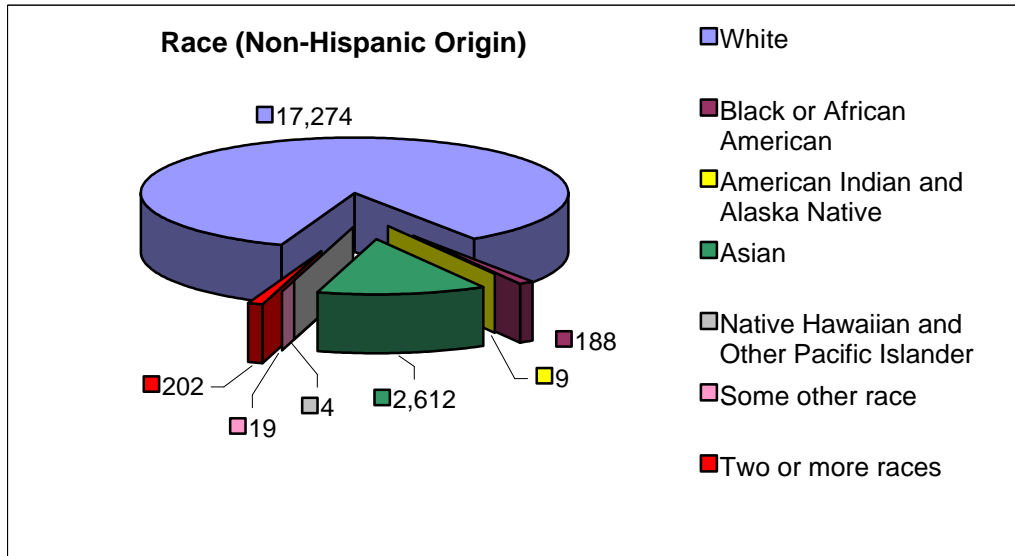
Stretching nine miles along the county's eastern border from Towaco in the north to Pine Brook in the south, Montville encompasses a variety of landscapes. French for "mountain town", Montville was incorporated in 1867. The lands along the Passaic and Rockaway Rivers were used for farming and grist milling. Today, Routes 46, 80, 202, and 287 pass through the township. With the completion of I-287 and easy access, Montville became the county's fastest growing municipality during the last decade.
